Public Hearing

Monday, June 15, 2020

Chairman Davis called a public hearing with the Board of Supervisors to order at 4:30 p.m. following salute to the flag. Supervisors Lee and Welka were present, as were, Zoning Administrator Cass, Solicitor Tim Wachter, Engineer Jonas, Secretary Yeast, and one interested person.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Davis explained that the purpose of the hearing is to receive public input regarding proposed Ordinance 2020-04 repealing a 1954 Ordinance known as the "Slaughterhouse Ordinance".

PURPOSE OF HEARING

Solicitor Wachter explained that the Township is currently in process of reviewing all ordinances and this particular Ordinance was adopted in 1954. Wachter added that United States and Pennsylvania Departments of Agriculture have "pre-empted the field", limiting any authority of the Township to regulate slaughterhouses and so, this ordinance is no longer necessary.
