**Public Hearing
February 3, 2025**

Chairman Welka called a public hearing of the Board of Supervisors to order at 6:00 p.m. followed by the salute to the flag. Supervisors Davis, Lee and Welka were present, as were Solicitor Wachter, Engineer Jonas, Zoning Administrator Cass, Secretary Vallimont, and three interested persons.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Welka explained that the purpose of the hearing is to receive public input regarding proposed amendments to the MS4 Pollution Reduction Plan.

PURPOSE OF
HEARING:

Engineer Jonas explained the amended plan proposes to renovate and retrofit an existing detention basin to reduce the sediment discharge in the Walnut Creek watershed within the township.

Jim Chojnacki asked who pays for this project, what is the cost estimate and when does it have to be done? Supervisor Welka explained that the township is required to pay the costs, approximately \$100,000.00 for a dry detention area and we have a few years to complete the task. This is another example of an unfunded mandate due to DEP's Clean Streams Act.
