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John Spaulding and Kip Hayford were present on behalf of Perry Hi-Way Hose Company (PHHC) to explain the need for adapters for all 500 fire hydrants in Summit Township. Mr. Spaulding explained that PHHC is working with the Summit Township Water Authority (STWA) to install a fire hydrant conversion storz adapter to allow fire departments to rapidly connect to the hydrant and get water flow for fire suppression activity. The funding request for these adapters is \$126,000, which will be funded to the STWA for the purchase and installation of these adapters.

Motion by Nesselhauf, seconded by Marsh, to grant the Summit Township Water Authority \$126,000.00 to purchase and install fire hydrant adapters for 500 fire hydrants.

With no further business to come before the Board, motion was made by Lee, seconded by Nesselhauf, to adjourn the meeting at 7:14 p.m.
